**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION
REPORT**

RESPONDENT.

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on October 18, 2003, pursuant to Rule 56(a), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) filed August 15, 2003, providing for a censure, one-year of probation with the Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings. Respondent, Respondent's counsel and counsel for the State Bar were present.

Decision

The eight¹ members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating by reference the Agreement² and Joint Memorandum³ providing for a censure, one-year of probation (LOMAP), and costs.

¹ Gary Bonwell, M.D., a former commissioner from Tucson, participated as an ad hoc member. One public member seat remains vacant. Commissioner Funkhouser recused.

² The Commission gives great weight to Respondent's lack of prior discipline.

³ The Joint Memorandum, pg. 4, item 2, inadvertently lists mitigating factor 9.32(a) absence of selfish or dishonest motive; this should be 9.32(b).
