RESPONDENT.

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on October 18, 2003, pursuant to Rule 56(a), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) filed August 4, 2003, providing for a sixty-day suspension, two years of probation with the Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) and the Member Assistance Program (MAP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings. Respondent, Respondent's counsel and counsel for the State Bar were present.

Decision

The nine¹ members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating by reference the Agreement and Joint Memorandum providing for a sixty-day suspension, two years of probation (LOMAP and MAP), and costs.
