AUGUSTINE, JR.**, a member of the State Bar of Arizona, currently on summary suspension, is hereby suspended from the practice of law for a period of two (2) years, effective the date of this order, for conduct in violation of his duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Commission report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **JOHN R. AUGUSTINE, JR.** shall pay restitution in the following amounts to the following individuals:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall comply with all the provisions of Rule 72, Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona, including, but not limited to, Rule 72(a), which requires that Respondent notify all of his clients within ten (10) days from the date hereof, of his inability to represent them and that he should promptly inform this Court of his compliance with this Order as provided in Rule 72(e).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall be assessed costs and expenses of the disciplinary proceedings as provided in Rule 60(b).
