This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on October 15, 2005, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed July 20, 2005 recommending a six month and one day suspension, two years of probation upon reinstatement with the State Bar's Member Assistance Program (MAP), and the State Bar's Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) with terms and conditions to be determined at the time of reinstatement, and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

Decision

The nine members of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation providing for a six month and one day suspension, two years of probation upon reinstatement (MAP and LOMAP) with terms and conditions to be determined at the
