**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION
REPORT**

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on January 21, 2006, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed November 7, 2005 recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) providing for censure and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

Decision

The nine members of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations for censure and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.¹ The Disciplinary Commission will not consider this matter in any future proportionality analysis.
