**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION
REPORT**

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on February 11, 2006, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed December 12, 2005, recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) providing for a four month suspension, one year of probation effective upon the signing of the probation contract with the State Bar's Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

Decision

The nine members of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for a four month suspension, one year of probation (LOMAP) effective
