This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on April 7, 2006, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed February 7, 2006, recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) providing for a censure, six months of probation effective upon the filing of the final Judgment and Order with the State Bar's Trust Account Ethics Enhancement Program (TAEHP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

Decision

The eight members¹ of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for censure, six months of probation effective upon the filing of the final
