This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on September 9, 2006, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed July 3, 2006, recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Joint Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent providing for censure, a term of probation with the State Bar's Trust Account Ethics Enhancement Program (TAEHP) and/or the State Bar's Trust Account Program (TAP), and costs.

Decision

The eight members¹ of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the of the Hearing Officer's findings of fact and conclusions of law,² and recommendation for censure, a term of probation (TAEHP and/or TAP),³ and

² The Commission determined that there is no evidence in the record to support consideration of the personal circumstances involving the illness and subsequent death of Respondent's Mother during the period of representation; the overall outcome however, is not affected.

³ The probation period will conclude upon completion of TAEHP; however, if Respondent remains a sole practitioner, the probation period will be for one year and Respondent shall enter into the State Bar's Trust Account Program (TAP).
