RESPONDENT.)	JUDGMENT AND ORDER

This matter having come on for hearing before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona, it having duly rendered its decision and there having been no discretionary review,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that **STEPHANIE K. BOND**, a member of the State Bar of Arizona, is hereby censured for conduct in violation of her duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Disciplinary Commission Report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **STEPHANIE K. BOND** shall be placed on probation for a period of one year effective upon the signing of the probation contract. Bar Counsel shall notify the Disciplinary Clerk of the date on which the probation begins. The terms of probation are as follows:

- 1) Respondent shall within thirty days of the signing of the probation contract, contact the State Bar’s Member Assistance Program Director to schedule an assessment to be conducted within the next 30 days. Respondent shall comply with all of the MAP Director or the director’s designee.
- 2) Respondent shall complete the Ethics Enhancement Program during the probation period.
- 3) Respondent shall follow all the Rules of Professional Conduct and Trust Account Guidelines. Respondent shall pay all costs incurred by the State Bar in connection with these proceedings, including the Member Assistant Program assessment.
- 4) In the event that Respondent fails to comply with any of the foregoing conditions, and the State Bar receives information to that effect, bar counsel shall file with the Hearing Officer a Notice of Non-Compliance, pursuant to Rule 60(a)5, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. The Hearing Officer shall conduct a hearing within thirty days after receipt of said notice, to determine whether the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be imposed. In the event there is an allegation that any of these terms have been violated, the burden of proof shall be on the State Bar of Arizona to prove non-compliance by clear and convincing evidence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 60(b), the State Bar of Arizona is granted judgment against **STEPHANIE K. BOND** for costs and expenses of these proceedings in the amount of \$851.90, together with interest at the legal rate from the date of this judgment.


