RESPONDENT.	)	JUDGMENT AND ORDER

This matter having come on for hearing before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona, it having duly rendered its decision and there having been no discretionary review,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that REX L. MARTIN, a member of the State Bar of Arizona, is hereby censured for conduct in violation of his duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Disciplinary Commission Report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that REX L. MARTIN shall be placed on probation for a period of two years. Bar Counsel shall notify the Disciplinary Clerk of the date on which the probation begins. The terms of probation are as follows:

- 1) Within thirty (30) days of the date of the final Judgment and Order, Respondent shall contact the Director of Member Assistance Program (MAP) and submit to a MAP assessment. Respondent thereafter, will enter into a MAP contract based upon the recommendations of the MAP director or designee and shall comply with the recommended terms.
- 2) Respondent shall pay all costs and expenses incurred in these disciplinary proceedings.
- 3) In the event that Respondent fails to comply with any of the foregoing conditions, and the State Bar receives information to that effect, bar counsel shall file with the Hearing Officer a Notice of Non-Compliance, pursuant to Rule 60(a)5, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. The Hearing Officer shall conduct a hearing within thirty days after receipt of said notice, to determine whether the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be imposed. In the event there is an allegation that any of these terms have been violated, the burden of proof shall be on the State Bar of Arizona to prove non-compliance by clear and convincing evidence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 60(b), the State Bar of Arizona is granted judgment against REX L. MARTIN for costs and expenses of these proceedings in the amount of \$600.00, together with interest at the legal rate from the date of this judgment.
