**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION  
REPORT**

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on August 11, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed June 15, 2007, recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent ("Tender") and Joint Memorandum ("Joint Memorandum") in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent providing for a six-month and one-day suspension, two years of probation with terms and conditions to be determined upon reinstatement, and costs.

**Decision**

The eight members<sup>1</sup> of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for a six-month and one-day suspension, two years of probation with terms and conditions to be determined upon reinstatement, and costs of these disciplinary
