8 This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of
 9 Arizona on February 10, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., for consideration of
 10 the Hearing Officer's Report filed November 24, 2006, recommending acceptance of the
 11 Tender of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Joint
 12 Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent
 13 providing for a six-month suspension, two years of probation upon reinstatement with the
 14 State Bar's Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP), Member Assistance
 15 Program (MAP), Ethics Enhancement Program (EEP), restitution, and costs.

Decision

18 The eight members¹ of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend
 19 accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and
 20 recommendation for six-month suspension, two years of probation upon reinstatement
 21 (LOMAP, MAP, EEP), restitution, and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.²
 22 Restitution and the terms of probation are as follows:

Terms of Probation

1 1. Within 30 days of reinstatement, Respondent shall contact the Director of
2 MAP and submit to a MAP assessment. Respondent thereafter will enter into a MAP
3 contract based upon the recommendations of the MAP director or designee and shall
4 comply with the recommended terms. The probation period commences upon
5 reinstatement and concludes two years from the date all parties have signed the contract.

6 2. Should Respondent relocate out of state, he is still required undergo the
7 assessment, and appropriate terms, if needed, will be developed to continue any
8 requirements in the other state. In accordance with the terms of the contract, Respondent
9 will continue to report compliance with any such terms to MAP.

10 3. Within 30 days of reinstatement, Respondent shall contact the Director of
11 LOMAP and submit to a LOMAP audit of his office's calendaring procedures and client
12 communication. Respondent thereafter will enter into a LOMAP contract based upon the
13 recommendations of the LOMAP director or designee and shall comply with the
14 recommended terms. Should Respondent relocate out of state, he will not be required to
15 complete this term. However, should Respondent resume the practice of law in Arizona
16 during the probationary period, Respondent shall immediately contact LOMAP and
17 comply with this term.

18 4. Respondent shall complete EEP during the probationary period.
