This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on November 18, 2006, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed July 28, 2006, recommending acceptance of the Tenders of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Amended Joint Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent providing for a six-month suspension retroactive to April 23, 2005 and run concurrently with his suspension in SB-05-002-D (2005), two years of probation upon reinstatement including fee arbitration with specific terms and conditions to be determined at the time of reinstatement, and costs.

Decision


The eight members¹ of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact and conclusions of law,² and

1 recommendation for a six-month suspension retroactive to April 23, 2005,³ and to run
2 concurrently with Respondent's previous suspension in File No. SB-05-002-D (2005), two
3 years of probation including participation in fee arbitration in File No. 05-1026 with
4 specific terms and conditions to be determined at the time of reinstatement, and costs of
5 these disciplinary proceedings.


