8 This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of
9 Arizona on February 10, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., for consideration of
10 the Hearing Officer's Report filed December 22, 2006, recommending acceptance of the
11 Tender of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Joint
12 Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent
13 providing for a six-month suspension to run concurrent with the suspension in File Nos.
14 03-1645, et al., two years of probation upon reinstatement with the State Bar's Member
15 Assistance Program (MAP), and costs.

17 **Decision**

18 The eight members¹ of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend
19 accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and
20 recommendation for a six-month suspension to run concurrent with the suspension
21 imposed in File Nos. 03-1645, et al., two years of probation upon reinstatement (MAP),
22 and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.² The terms of probation are as follows:
