17 Arizona on November 17, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., for consideration of
18 the Hearing Officer's Report filed October 3, 2007, recommending acceptance of the
19 Tender of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Joint
20 Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent
21 providing for censure and costs.


