This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on May 19, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed February 21, 2007 recommending a six-month and one-day suspension, a minimum of one year of probation upon reinstatement with the State Bar's Member Assistance Program (MAP) and costs.

Decision

The eight members¹ of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact and conclusions of law, but modify the recommendation to reflect disbarment and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.²


Because of substance abuse problems, Respondent was conditionally admitted to practice law in Arizona in July 2005 and was ordered to participate in MAP.³ Respondent thereafter, failed to comply with conditions of his admission. Specifically, Respondent

1 failed to comply with the MAP contract by failing to maintain contact with his MAP
2 monitor and failing to submit to random biological testing.

3 Therefore, based on Respondent's conditional admission to practice law, his
4 failure to abide by conditions of admission, his failure to participate in this matter, and
5 moreover, in order to protect the public, the Commission concludes that disbarment is the
6 appropriate sanction.
