This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on December 8, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed November 19, 2007, recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Joint Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent providing for a two-year suspension retroactive to August 31, 2005,<sup>1</sup> two years of probation upon reinstatement with terms and conditions to be determined at the time of reinstatement, fee arbitration, and costs.


**Decision**

Having found no facts clearly erroneous, the nine members of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for a two years suspension retroactive to August 31, 2005, two years of probation upon reinstatement with specific

and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.<sup>2</sup>


