**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION  
REPORT**

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on December 8, 2007, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed November 23, 2007, recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and the Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and the Joint Memorandum (Joint Memorandum) in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent providing for censure, one year of probation with the State Bar's Trust Account Ethics Enhancement Program (TAEPP), and costs.

**Decision**

Having found no facts clearly erroneous, the nine members of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for censure, one year of probation (TAEPP) and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.<sup>1</sup> The terms of probation are as follows:

**Terms of Probation**

1. Respondent shall complete TAEPP within the probation period.
