

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1 The Disciplinary Commission Report in the above captioned matter is hereby adopted by the Commission, and it shall be filed by the Disciplinary Clerk
- 2 Respondent and the State Bar may file with the Disciplinary Clerk a Notice of Intent to File a Petition for Review by the Supreme Court within ten days of service of the Disciplinary Commission Report. The petition for review is due 20 days thereafter, and a cross-petition for review may be filed within 15 days after service of a petition for review, pursuant to Rule 59(a). The form and contents of the petitions shall comply with Rule 59(d)
- 3 If no Petition for Review is timely filed, the Disciplinary Clerk, under the provisions of Rule 59(i), shall prepare and file a certificate attesting to those facts and submit this matter to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for entry of Judgment of Suspension, pursuant to Rule 60(a)(2).
- 4 If a Petition for Review is filed, upon the expiration of the time for filing a Cross-Petition for Review, the Disciplinary Clerk shall transmit a partial record to the Clerk of the Supreme Court pursuant to Rule 59(c).

5 In the event a Petition for Review is granted, or if ordered by the Court, *sua sponte*, the Disciplinary Clerk shall transmit the entire record to the Clerk of the Supreme Court pursuant to Rule 59(h) and (i).
