This matter having come before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona, it having duly rendered its decision and there having been no discretionary review,


IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that **MICHAEL J. NYSATHER**, a member of the State Bar of Arizona, is hereby censured for conduct in violation of his duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Disciplinary Commission Report

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **MICHAEL J. NYSATHER** shall be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year Bar Counsel shall notify the Disciplinary Clerk of the date on which the probation begins. The terms of probation are as follows

- 1 Respondent shall enter into a contract and Memorandum of Understanding with LOMAP for a law office review including supervision of subordinate attorneys, contact with court personnel, and calendaring and docket control procedures
- 2 Respondent shall complete a CLE program regarding law office management

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 60(b), the State Bar of Arizona is granted judgment against **MICHAEL J. NYSATHER** for costs and expenses of these proceedings in the amount of \$750 00 together with interest at the legal rate from the date of this judgment
