

ADULT PROBATION Narrative Summary

There are **three pages** of tables for statewide and county adult probation activity. The first page is the **Total Adult Probation (Standard and Intensive) Case Activity**, the second covers **Standard Adult Probation** alone, and the third only **Intensive Adult Probation**. On each page there are **three tables**. The first table concerns the general **Probation Population** (active and absconders), the second table concerns **Probationers with Petitions to Revoke**, and the third table summarizes **Additional Probation Activity**.

There were a total of 40,567 individuals added to the active **standard and intensive probation** population and 13,917 added to the absconder population during FY 2006. As of the end of FY 2006, there were 39,984 active standard and intensive probationers and 13,913 absconders in Arizona, a total of 53,897 individuals. A total of 10,400 petitions to revoke were filed during the fiscal year, and 9,465 absconders were apprehended and brought back before the court. Of all the probation violation matters brought back before the court in FY 2006, dispositions were achieved in 19,440 cases and there were 3,305 petitions to revoke pending at the end of the fiscal year. Additionally, probationers completed 1,397,442 community service hours in FY 2006 (10.3% less than FY 2005) and probation officers completed 37,213 presentence reports (up 15.0% over FY 2005). Standard and intensive probationers paid \$44,282,751 in restitution, reimbursement, fines, surcharges and fees (12.9% increase over FY 2005) and intensive probationers paid \$2,475,156 in state and federal income taxes.

There were 34,974 individuals added to the active **standard** probation population and 12,625 added to the standard absconder population in FY 2006. During the fiscal year, 32,098 individuals were terminated from standard probation and 12,064 absconder warrants were closed. On June 30, 2006, there were 37,105 active standard probationers and 12,851 standard probation absconders. A total of 8,451 petitions to revoke were filed on standard probationers during FY 2006, and 8,499 absconders were apprehended and brought back before the court. Of all the standard probation violation matters brought back before the court, dispositions were achieved in 16,618 cases, leaving 2,793 petitions to revoke pending at the end of the fiscal year. Standard probationers completed 742,319 community service hours and paid a total of \$41,821,179 in court ordered penalties.

During FY 2006, 5,593 individuals were added to the active **intensive** probation population and 1,292 added to the intensive absconder population. Over the course of the fiscal year, 5,715 individuals were terminated from intensive probation and 1,094 absconder warrants were closed. At the close of the fiscal year there were 2,879 active intensive probationers and 1,062 intensive probation absconders. A total of 1,949 petitions to revoke were filed on intensive probationers during FY 2006 and 966 absconders were apprehended and brought back before the court. Of all the intensive probation violation matters brought back before the court, 2,822 reached disposition, leaving 512 intensive petitions to revoke pending at the end of the fiscal year. Intensive probationers completed 655,123 hours of community service and paid \$4,936,728 in fines, restitution and other monies.
