

**COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION ONE**  
**Narrative Summary**

Division One of the Court of Appeals experienced an decrease in case filings in fiscal year 2006. Total filings decreased by 4.9%, from 2,970 in FY 2005 to 2,825 in FY 2006. Post Conviction Relief and Unemployment Board case categories showed the greatest numerical decrease in filings, decreasing by 256 (34.0%) and 76 (46.6%) respectively, from the previous fiscal year. Criminal case filings experienced the largest numerical increase (85 or 15.4%), followed by Civil cases (83 or 10.2%). Juvenile case filings increased by 28.9% and Industrial Commission case filings decreased by 19.9%, from FY 2005 to FY 2006.

Total case dispositions showed an increase, from 2,630 in FY 2005 to 3,104 in FY 2005, an increase of 18.0%.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 2,502 on July 1, 2005 to 2,329 on June 30, 2006, a decrease of 6.9%.

A new mental health case filing category was added in fiscal year 2000, called Mental Health (MH) Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Division One began breaking out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category in fiscal year 2003, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases in fiscal year 2000.


