

COURT PERSONNEL

Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide summary reflects all court positions as of June 30, 2006, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed electronically in August 2006.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Arizona judicial system increased from 9,123 in FY 2005 to 9,699 in FY 2006, a 6.3% increase. The courts employed an additional 1,067 part-time personnel, down 0.4% from 1,071 in FY 2005.

The most notable increases in full-time personnel appear to be in the position of deputy court clerk (2,100 to 2,284) and juvenile probation detention officers (600 to 744). The largest decrease in full-time personnel appears to be in the position of "other" probation officer (383 to 282).

The courts also had the services of 1,947 regular volunteers, a decrease of 3.3% from the 2,013 in FY 2005. Volunteers include attorneys, court reporters, teachers, mediators, information desk personnel, Court Appointed Special Advocates, Foster Care Review Board members, and other professionals and non-professionals who serve as on-call magistrates.

Additionally, the courts utilized 109,776 hours of temporary personnel assistance. This is equivalent to 13,722 person-days, or over 52 full-time employees (at 260 working days per year).

Some of the FY 2005 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Personnel reports received from courts are checked for anomalies, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
