

COURT ANNUAL CASE ACTIVITY Narrative Summary

Total filings (including transfers in) increased by 4.5% in FY 2007, from 2,551,720 in FY 2006 to 2,666,450 in FY 2007.

Criminal filings decreased from 454,375 in FY 2006 to 449,856 in FY 2007, a decrease of 1.0%. Civil filings increased 5.7%, from 315,615 in FY 2006 to 334,741 in FY 2007. Traffic filings (applicable only in justice and municipal courts) increased by 7.8%, from 1,585,102 last year to 1,708,581 in FY 2007.

Total dispositions (including transfers out) increased by 4.6% from 2,612,139 in FY 2006 to 2,732,924 in FY 2007.

Orders of protection petitions rose 0.7%, from 33,009 in FY 2006 to 33,240 in FY 2007. Emergency orders of protection increased 8.7%, from 104 last year to 113 in FY 2007. Injunctions against harassment petitions decreased 0.1%, from 22,078 in FY 2006 to 22,058 in FY 2007.

The total number of trials held in the Arizona courts decreased in FY 2007 by 22.0% from 50,433 last year to 39,355 in FY 2007. The vast majority were court trials in limited jurisdiction courts. During FY 2006, Maricopa Justice Court Administration trained their court staff to count all appearances with a judge relating to forcible detainer cases as a court trial resulting in a sharp decrease in court trials from FY2006 to FY2007.

There were 916 cases filed (including 60 reopened cases) in the Arizona Tax Court during FY 2007, representing a 13.2% increase from the 765 cases filed in FY 2006. Arizona Tax Court filings are reported in Superior Court category in the statewide totals.

Some of the FY 2006 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Statistical reports received from courts are checked for mathematical accuracy, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.

COURT REVENUE Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide revenue data is provided here for each level of the Arizona courts. The first table shows the source and distribution of revenues collected by courts. The figures were compiled from probation fee reports and the quarterly revenue surveys distributed by the Supreme Court for FY 2007. Major revenue categories shown represent monies collected from four sources:

FINES, SANCTIONS, FORFEITURES: Revenue from monetary penalties assessed in criminal, traffic, and juvenile matters, and bond monies that were forfeited;

SURCHARGES: Revenue from monetary assessments authorized by statute above and beyond criminal and traffic penalties and certain civil and other fees;

FEES: Revenue from collectible fees for services of the court and chargeable aspects of case processing;

OTHER REVENUE: Revenue from sources not otherwise specified.

Total revenue collected by the Arizona courts increased from \$323,174,227 in FY 2006 to \$358,475,845 in FY 2007, an increase of 10.9%.

The first table shows that the fines category accounts for \$140,263,184, or 39.1% of the total. Fees make up the second largest segment of court revenue, totaling \$132,537,965, or 37.0%. The third largest revenue category is surcharges, with \$82,971,157, or 23.1% of the total revenue.

The second table shows that FY2007 court revenue, as in previous years, is distributed fairly evenly among the state, counties, and municipalities (30.0%-38.7%), and that Municipal Courts generate a little over half of all court revenue (\$181,210,933, or 50.6%). The third table (on the same page) shows that the Arizona courts processed \$164,837,068 in "pass-through" trust monies, of which restitution accounted for \$19,237,249 of the total. The majority collected was in "bail bonds", which represents 44.2% of the total.

The establishment of a central support payment clearinghouse to receive, disburse and monitor support payments pursuant to title IV-D of the Social Security Act, which started to take effect in FY 1998, has moved all child support payments from the courts to the Department of Economic Security. The courts only collected \$50,551 in FY 2007.

COURT EXPENDITURES

Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide expenditure information is provided here for each level of the Arizona courts. The first table shows court expenditures by source, fund, or other category. These data were compiled from Supreme Court financial records, program fund reversion reports, and annual expenditure surveys submitted to the Supreme Court for FY 2007. Major expenditure categories shown represent monies expended from five sources:

PRIMARY BUDGET: Expenditures of appropriated funds from the court's primary funding source, either the state (Supreme Court and Court of Appeals), the county (Superior and Justice Courts), or the city or town (Municipal Courts)--categories are kept as general as possible because line-item definitions for the state, counties, and municipalities vary widely;

STATE FUNDS: Expenditures of state program monies begun or renewed by the Arizona legislature and distributed to the courts;

FEDERAL FUNDS: Expenditures of federal program monies begun or renewed by the U.S. Congress and distributed to the courts (often via state agencies);

LOCAL FUNDS: Examples are expenditures from collections authorized by statute to reimburse all or part of the expenses of probation, automation, and other court services;

PRIVATE FUNDS: Expenditures of additional grants from other sources.

Total expenditures in the Arizona courts increased from \$631,635,155 to \$701,756,806 in FY 2007, up 11.1%. Primary budget expenditures account for 74.5% of the total. Salary and fringe benefit expenditures account for the largest portion (81.4%) of the primary budget. Outside primary budget expenditures, state funds account for the next largest group, at 17.5%.

The second table shows, as in previous years, that Arizona counties contributed more than half of the funds to operate the state's courts this year (\$451,206,163 or 64.2%). Likewise, the state again contributed approximately one-fourth of courts' expenditures in FY 2007 (\$147,985,687, or 21.1%). Expenditures from four out of five sources increased in FY 2007, and again, over two-thirds of these expenses were at the Superior Court level (\$497,243,791, or 70.9%).

Some of the FY 2006 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Expenditure reports received from courts are checked for mathematical accuracy, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.

COURT PERSONNEL

Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide summary reflects all court positions as of June 30, 2007, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey distributed electronically in August 2007.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Arizona judicial system increased from 9,628 in FY 2006 to 9,862 in FY 2007, a 2.4% increase. The courts employed an additional 1,223 part-time personnel, up 11.9% from 1,093 in FY 2006.

The most notable increases in full-time personnel appear to be in the position of probation/detention officer supervisor (172 to 216) and court general support (199 to 266). The largest decrease in full-time personnel appears to be in the position of court support staff (745 to 653).

The courts also had the services of 1,780 regular volunteers, a decrease of 8.6% from the 1,947 in FY 2006. Volunteers include attorneys, court reporters, teachers, mediators, information desk personnel, Court Appointed Special Advocates, Foster Care Review Board members, and other professionals and non-professionals who serve as on-call magistrates.

Additionally, the courts utilized 101,814 hours of temporary personnel assistance. This is equivalent to 12,726 person-days, or over 48 full-time employees (at 260 working days per year).

Some of the FY 2006 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Personnel reports received from courts are checked for anomalies, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.
