
SUPREME COURT Narrative Summary

During fiscal year 2013, there were 1,054 cases filed in the Supreme Court, a decrease of 5.0% in total filings from the 1,109 cases filed in FY 2012. The categories with the largest numerical decreases were the petitions for review criminal cases, which decreased by 11.9% from 493 in FY 2012 to 437 in FY 2013, and petitions for review civil cases (4.2%), which dropped from 331 in FY 2012 to 317 in FY 2013. State bar matters had the most notable increase in filings, up from 50 in FY 2012 to 62 in FY 2013, a 24.0% increase.

During the same period, the Supreme Court disposed of 1,145 cases, an increase of 6.0% from the 1,080 cases disposed during the previous fiscal year.


The difference between filings and terminations resulted in a pending caseload decrease of 20.7%, from 421 cases on July 1, 2012 to 334 cases on June 30, 2013.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION ONE
Narrative Summary

Division One of the Court of Appeals experienced a decrease in case filings during fiscal year 2013. Total filings decreased by 3.5%, from 2,910 in FY 2012 to 2,809 in FY 2013. Unemployment Board cases experienced the largest numerical decrease in filings (138 or 32.1%). Post Conviction Relief cases had the greatest numerical increase in filings, increasing by 84 (27.0%) compared with the previous fiscal year.

Total case dispositions decreased from 3,003 in FY 2012 to 2,936 in FY 2013, a decrease of 2.2%. Post Conviction Relief decreased in terminations by 105 cases or 22.3% from FY 2012 to FY 2013. Civil cases had the greatest increase in terminations from 824 in FY 2012 to 916 in FY 2013, an increase of 11.2%.

The total pending caseload figure decreased by 197 cases from 2,248 on July 1, 2012 to 2,051 on June 30, 2013, a decrease of 8.8%.




COURT OF APPEALS, DIVISION ONE



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION TWO Narrative Summary

Division Two of the Court of Appeals had no significant change in case filings over the fiscal year. Original filings increased by one case, from 841 in FY 2012 to 842 in FY 2013. The most notable increase was in the Civil case filing category which increased by 34.4%, from 131 filings in FY 2012 to 176 in FY 2013. Juvenile cases reported the largest numerical decrease in filings, dropping by 15 cases from 153 in FY 2012 to 138 in FY 2013, a decrease of 9.8%.


Dispositions showed an increase of 60.4%, from 652 in FY 2012 to 1,046 in FY 2013. The largest increase was in the Post Conviction Relief case category, which went from 122 cases terminated in FY2012 to 262 cases terminated in FY2013, an increase of 114.8% or 140 case terminations. The Civil category experienced an increase of 104.7%, from 107 in FY 2012 to 219 in FY 2013, an additional 112 cases terminated during FY 2013.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 915 on July 1, 2012 to 870 on June 30, 2013, a decrease of 4.9%. The Civil case category showed the greatest numerical change in pending caseload, decreasing by 43 cases from 183 in FY 2012 to 143 in FY 2013.
