

It is sad to watch this commission struggle so mightily because of its current (past) makeup--- only bureaucrats. This commission needs a technical person who can turn the multiple and conflicting requirements of the redistricting law into a result. This is a job for an engineer. I spent my life dealing with conflicting and very complicated requirements in the engineering world. The expertise I gained during my career resulted in my being appointed Chief Engineer at the Honeywell Corporation—a position of great responsibility in the Gas Turbine Industry. My division designs, develops and manufactures engines that power passenger aircraft and I was until my retirement, a significant contributor to Honeywell's success in this industry.

In addition to my work experience I am also trained in 6-sigma. This is a methodology embraced by many major companies which helps guide complicated projects through to success and is a proven method of solving problems through use of facts and data rather than opinion and feelings.

I have had limited contact with bureaucrats and the political process through the City of Chandler. I did run for the non-partisan Chandler City Council (unsuccessfully) in 2004.
