Resume

For the last 43 years, I have been involved in the lighting business. Starting in 1968 with a manufacturer, I was responsible for the western states visiting and promoting lighting products for television studios and motion picture production companies. I became the National Sales Mgr of that company and was responsible for the entire United States. I started to travel outside of the country in 1974 with a trip to Brazil. This was followed by trips to all of the countries of South America as well as Mexico. I was appointed as Vice President of Sales and traveled to countries in the Far East for ten years.

I later joined another company as Vice President, International Sales and remain there as an employee and a rep for eleven years. I started my own company in 1986 as a manufacturer's representative. My company has been doing business exclusively in Mexico since the beginning of the business.
