





History of Standardization

- ▶ Kickoff in 2004
- ▶ Deliverables
 - Standard Code Sets defined for use in new Case Management Systems
 - Established Data Standards Committee to administer and maintain integrity of code sets
 - AOC Data Standards Lead approved
- ▶ Code Sets delivered, approved, adopted
- ▶ Data Standards Committee established
- ▶ AOC Data Standards Lead position filled



GJ Courts

- ▶ Work in 2007 and 2008
 - Analysis of codes for CourTools and Statistical Reporting
 - 17 new Criminal case sub-types
 - 43 new Civil, Juvenile and Family Law case sub-types
 - Triggers for inactive and active cases
 - AGAVE Set Up/ Mapping
 - Cactis codes > Standardization > AGAVE
 - AJACS Set Up/ Mapping
 - AZTEC codes > Standardization > AJACS
 - Individual GJ Court mapping effort




GJ COURTS (CONTINUED)

 - New Tables for Managing Case Financials


- ▶ Defined 85 standard business processes for use in AJACS

 - New and Amended Court Rules




How It All Got Done!
