

CACC HIGHLIGHTS

From CACC Meeting of 6/25/03

Budget

- ✓ DDS was left intact
- ✓ JCEF was hit for 2m per year
- ✓ Trailer Bill failed
- ✓ Will focus on re-assessing strategy at next COT meeting

TAC

- ✓ Re-assessing strategy by looking at future models
- ✓ We need a model that spurs innovation and allows for leveraging
- ✓ Need to continue focusing on standardization
- ✓ Next TAC set for early August
 - Recording Standards
 - FTR Gold seemed to be the one, but now courts are looking at other options.
 - Need reliable formats and storage (standards)
- ✓ Crystal Reports
 - Pima evaluated Brio and was highly impressed
 - Easily converted existing Crystal calendar reports, easy to use
 - With Crystal we face huge licensing fees
 - Will need to consider and weigh transition issues and cost

FARE

- ✓ Handouts from Janet Scheiderer
- ✓ Partner is ACS
- ✓ Looking for proof of concept with pioneer courts

CFS

- ✓ Demo was held since last CACC meeting to show progress
- ✓ Analysts 1 month ahead
- ✓ Developers packaging up bundles to install for testing
- ✓ Table structure issue
 - Who will manage and maintain state tables

AZTEC

- ✓ 4 courts in pilot for e-dispo
- ✓ Flag JP says going very well
 - Allowed them to clean up back-log, and are now focusing on rejects
- ✓ Flag Muni going well
 - Minor hiccup during implementation but consider this a valuable tool
- ✓ First 50 courts by end of September
- ✓ 23 AZTEC changes for Pima identified as helpful to all courts will be addressed first
- ✓ FARE changes and interfaces being identified
- ✓ Line to MVD via Houston (GITA) is up. This will provide interface in AZTEC > MVD
 - Will save keystrokes and improve data quality

- Response time is good
- ✓ MCJPC gap is 60% complete. Process went well. Good learning exercise for both AOC and JP court
- ✓ APETS getting ready to go live in Yuma County
- ✓ Re-thinking direction of future statewide cms.
 - This summer we will survey the market for AZTEC replacement in LJ courts
 - ✓ Will look at functional needs of MCJPC, East Valley, and various other courts to determine possibilities

PAM

- ✓ Training took place June 9-10
- ✓ Tentative go live in remaining courts on July 1
- ✓ List of fixes being analyzed and readied for next version
