
Foundational Principles

- **Must be a statewide system for all our courts**; General Jurisdiction, Limited Jurisdiction, and Appellate
- **Must apply to all types of cases**, e.g. criminal, civil, special actions, etc.
- We **must adopt a system that is court-powered and court-managed**. The Court must maintain its independence from excessive reliance on any one entity or vendor. Additionally, the Court shall maintain ownership and control of case data and documents.
- The system we choose **must be a first-class e-filing system**. The system must provide, eventually if not initially, all the services that court users need, including initial filing and service of process.


Scope

- Form- and free-form based Web solutions for all court levels and case types
- Single vendor award
 - Vendor has a working system capable of meeting the needs of the Judiciary
 - Vendor will supply the Court a robust EFM that facilitates e-filing submissions between e-filers and all courts
 - Multi-year award with option to extend




