Contract

- Awarded to Intresys
- Signed January 26, 2009
- 4 Year Contract Term
- Options to extend contract up to three times in two year increments (potential life of 10 years)
- \$1.94M Base Contract Value
- Fee per transaction paid to the Vendor

Scope

- All Courts; All Case Types
- AOC Maintains E-Filing System Infrastructure & Help Desk
- Initial Pilot Courts:
 - Maricopa Superior – General Civil, Family
 - Maricopa JP – General Civil, Small Claims, Eviction Actions
- Follow-On Pilot Courts
 - Division One
 - Supreme Court
- All Others

- First Deliverable due March 12, 2009
 - Investigate Clerk/Judge Review Processes
 - Assess Forms Analysis & Deployment Schedules
 - Produce Detailed SOW and Project Schedule
- Second Deliverable due Summer 2009

- Pleading (free-form) Based




