On [ ] an employee of [ ]  
[ ] was radar cited for speeding. He was driving a truck owned by me and  
leased to [ ] The citation was in my name because of owner ship of the  
vehicle.

The proper fine amount was mailed to [ ] Court along with the  
paperwork explaining that [ ] and not [ ] was the driver  
of the vehicle when the violation occurred.

In [ ] I received a letter from [ ] insurance company  
telling me that a citation appeared on my driving record and that my insurance  
premiums would be increased because of it.

I have written to Judge [ ] on three occasions asking that I be allowed  
to appear in court in order to show that I was not driving the vehicle when the  
radar photo was made.

Three times he has denied me a chance to prove that [ ] made the  
mistake and that the citation was applied to the wrong driving record.

I am attaching copies of my letters to the court, a letter from [ ] to the  
court and the court's replies to my plea for a chance to get the citation removed  
from my Arizona MVD record.

I did not commit the offense and would like the citation removed from my record.  
Judge [ ] will not allow me that opportunity.
