FORMAL COMPLAINT

I am writing to you in reference to my many attempts to file an appeal in your court. Your front counter assistant has misguided me, instructing me to go to the Superior Court to file my appeal on the above case number. I pleaded with them to file an appeal the day that the judge squashed it. They insisted on charging me \$50, which was unlawful in the appeal process.
