I would like to file a complaint against [redacted] Superior Court Judge [redacted] for allowing me, [redacted] to be maliciously pursued for prosecutions by granting a search warrant for my home based on false information. Attached to this document, you will find the affidavit that Judge [redacted] signed that allowed thirty men to search my home based on false information. Consideration should have been given as to my position in the community, as I WORKED for the [redacted] and now I have been suspended without pay, all because Judge [redacted] didn't review the information and verify the affidavit as accurate. I suggest that due to my status as a woman in [redacted] and my prior [redacted] activity, I was targeted and I am being maliciously pursued for prosecution by [redacted]. Further, there is no video tape of me leaving the casino with a stolen purse or any purse as the affidavit states. Judge [redacted] should have demanded to see evidence before he issued a search warrant of my home. Now, I have been suspended with no pay and will lose my job. My reputation has been ruined over false information and malicious prosecution. Can you please look into this situation.
