To whom it may concern,

I'm writing due to my concern over my experience at a hearing in [redacted] City Court on [redacted] where I contested an Injunction Against Harassment issued to me, because I had not been around the plaintiff at all. I had been granted an Injunction Against Harassment that included my [redacted]-year-old daughter, [redacted] on [redacted]

I requested the order upon suggestion of the [redacted] Domestic Violence Services to protect my daughter and self from [redacted] who has been having an inappropriate relationship with my daughter who is a runaway.

[redacted] harbors my daughter who unfortunately now is 4 months pregnant. As witnesses will attest; yet when questioned by police denies that she has been staying there. He has also admitted paternity of the baby my daughter is expecting in March 2007.

There is a warrant for my daughter's arrest for absconding her probation with the [redacted] County Juvenile Court, as she is a chronic runaway. [redacted] was even seen meeting with [redacted] at a convenience store by other residence of the group home where she was ordered by the court to reside after he was served with the injunction. This was reported to the police when [redacted] went missing the following day. It has also been reported to [redacted] County Juvenile Probation, [redacted] Police Dept., and AZ. Children and Family Protection-Protective Services. I've been told by [redacted] and [redacted] that they can't get a warrant to enter [redacted] home to remove my daughter.

Judicial Officer, [redacted] due to the Plaintiff's absence, dismissed the injunction that I contested not because I am innocent. I brought my innocence to the Judicial Officers attention twice, yet he ignored me. I brought my mother [redacted] also named on the dismissed injunction, who had witnessed my daughter enter [redacted] residence. She was not recognized by the court. I was not given the opportunity to tell why she was there, and she was not asked. I also brought a letter written by [redacted] explaining the note from my mother that [redacted] used as reason for his need for an Injunction Against Harassment, but was not allowed to present it. [redacted] rushed me out of the hearing without hearing me at all. He did however in closing tell me not to send anyone over to [redacted] house as if to say I don't believe you, and you are just lucky [redacted] is not present.

The bottom line is I'm innocent of what the injunction against me alleged. [redacted] who served the injunction, is guilty of harboring and impregnating a [redacted]-year-old girl. And, Judicial Officer, [redacted] was guilty of telling me not to interrupt [redacted] in his abuse of my child when he said "Don't you send anyone over there.". In my opinion [redacted] employed a rude and pompous demeanor in court, and my experience in his court was one of injustice and disrespect. I think it is important that your commission know of my experience.

I would like Judicial Officer, [redacted] to be aware of the entirety of Court Case No. [redacted] when considering [redacted] injunction that I contested. I am awaiting your reply.
