Since assigned the case in [redacted] - I have been not allowed to respond to Plaintiff claims due to her attorney and judge mailed me orders, either to wrong address or to my attorney who had signed off several months before, I was assigned family advisor for months before I knew about him, and several orders and reports made against me without my knowledge. When I found out judge assigned advisor, response time had passed for me and I was unfairly slandered. I was ordered to pay to see advisor at [redacted] hr for evaluate joint custody issues that I knew nothing about. I told advisor I couldn't afford him or needed to see him because (A) I am disabled can't afford and (B) didn't know there was issues. I attempted to contact judge several times and no return calls. The opposing party has seen the advisor many times and can't afford the fee's. I have been accused, by judge for lying and say I knew nothing of the orders, or my ability to pay community debts. I meet the judge 1st time [redacted] explained my situation and he ignored my pleas and threatened me with jail time for not paying debts when I told him I was disabled and unable. He has been biased, discriminatory because of my disability, unfair to fair hearing, and slandering my name - forcing me to take unfair test do to hearsay

I feel I have been unjustly looked at as a bad father to my child, by the courts and advisor. I told the advisor I couldn't afford him and wanted another one closer and affordable, the advisor told me, either I pay or I will lose. He told me he was going to make his recommendations without me being able to speak to him. He has had my home address from day one and not one report has come to me. He lied to judge saying I refused to come in, and nothing about my disability. I requested a mediator and was not properly used for me to speak. The advisor has made ~~off~~ decisions with at times being appointed according to court documents - I have been treated so unjust I now ~~may~~ may lose my child in a joint custody established, and go to jail because I haven't been heard, or able to pay for help. The judge is unfair and the advisor too.

I request a new judge and advisor with all records thrown out and facts be proven again with my knowledge and rights to due process
