I was in a hearing with Commissioner _____ on _____ She was very rude, and exhibited Willful Misconduct in Office, Willful and Persistent Failure to Perform Duties, and Conduct that Brings the Judicial Office into Disrepute. She was not willing to hear me out and when I explained to her that this is my case, thus I should talk or say something, she cut me off and refused to listen to me. This is clearly a violation of the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct. Furthermore, I called Commissioner _____ judicial assistant for a court reporter, and she was unwilling to help me out. On the _____ I filed a motion stating that I felt Commissioner _____ would be unfair in my trial, as she is misusing her powers, and I specifically asked for a jury trial. I filed this motion ahead of time, as the trial date was on the _____ day of _____ yet, Commissioner _____ did not respond to my motion. On the day of my trial, she denied my motion for a jury trial, and proceeded with the trial. Commissioner _____ denied my constitutional right to a jury trial. She misused her powers to stick it to me. She was out to get me and was very unfair, as she really didn't even let me talk about the damage done to my property. She did this intentionally and also made references to the time, as she said it was getting late and that she had to go home because it was approaching 4:30 P.M.
