- Court improperly rules on asset allocation after ADR conference.

- Court hears testimony of Family Court Advisor that child's mother has not cooperated with FCA in "about a year" but does nothing.

- Court adopts recommendations of FCA. Father completes, mother does not, court does nothing when notified. Orders still outstanding.

- Court fails to make ruling on child's living arrangements. Child now commutes 50+ miles to school, and is being held back for poor performance.

- Court orders a second evaluation for both parents, even though an evaluation was completed a mere 10 months before.

Also - Court has allowed respondent's attorney to act improperly regarding asset division and child support pleadings.

Since parenting plan was introduced in [redacted] Mother has withheld child from father 7 weeks. Court has done nothing when notified.
