**ORDER**

The commission reviewed the complaint filed in this matter and determined that the judge's absences did not violate the ethical standards. The commission found that the judge had a system for reviewing files that resulted in untimely rulings. Upon learning of the complaint, the judge expressed regret for the delay and immediately implemented a new system to ensure that all matters will be decided in a timely basis in the future. Because of the judge's prompt action, the commission voted to dismiss the case and to issue a private comment to the judge.

The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).
