Dear Commissioner:

I recently filed a motion with the [Redacted] Superior Court to have my child support payments stopped. My son turned 18 years of age on [Redacted] and moved out of his mother's house on the [Redacted]. His mother is no longer entitled to have child support payments made to her.

I have enclosed my motion to STOP CHILD SUPPORT for your viewing pleasure and in the upper left corner you can see that I requested a telephonic hearing. As of today, May 24th, I still have not heard from the Court allowing a telephonic hearing. I wrote a letter on May 14th requesting a phone number but the Court will not respond. I currently live in [Redacted] and appearing in [Redacted] is a hardship.

I have paid my child support on time for thirteen years and now is the time for child support to stop. I want my property rights restored that are guaranteed to me under the Constitution.

Furthermore, the [Redacted] Court website does not contain any information on how to have child support stopped nor does it contain the proper procedures to have this done. It is my opinion that there is heavy-handed enforcement to pay child support but no enforcement to ensure child support monies are in fact used for the benefit of the child.

I request that you contact Judge [Redacted] and inquire as to why a telephonic hearing was not granted under the original pleading and a telephone number was not listed for me and the respondent to call into. This is not a hard matter to resolve.
