AGAIN WRITTEN A LETTER TO THE COURT DUE TO THE RESPONDENTS LACK OF COOPERATION. WHEN I LAST SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] ON [REDACTED] HE HAD NOT RECEIVED A RESPONSE FROM THE COURT.

MY COMPLAINT DEALS WITH THE LACK OF ENFORCEMENT ON THE COURTS PART ON ITS OWN ORDERS. BECAUSE OF THIS UNWILLINGNESS OF THE COURT TO FORCE THE SALE OF THE HOUSE, THE HOUSE WAS SOLD AT AUCTION DUE TO FORECLOSURE. MY 2 YOUNGEST CHILDREN WHO WERE LIVING WITH THEIR MOTHER ARE SOON TO BE HOMELESS. I HAVE NOW OVER [REDACTED] IN DEBT, MOST OF WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN PAID BY THE SALE OF THE HOME. THE DIVORCE DECREE CANNOT BE FOLLOWED AS THE ONLY ASSET IN THE MARRIAGE WAS THE HOUSE. EVERY ORDER THE COURT GAVE ME I HAVE FOLLOWED. THE RESPONDENT HAS LITERALLY THUMBED HER NOSE AT THE COURT AND GOT AWAY WITH IT DUE TO JUDGE [REDACTED] FAILURE TO ENFORCE HER OWN ORDERS. AS A RESULT, I AM NOW PAYING SPOUSAL SUPPORT TO THE RESPONDENT AS WELL AS HAVING ALL THE DEBT ON MY SHOULDERS. I ATTEMPTED TO GET THE FORECLOSURE POSTPONED BUT A NEW JUDGE REFUSED.
