**ORDER**

The commission reviewed the complaint filed in this matter and found no misconduct on the part of either judge. The first judge did not know the complainant at the time the injunction against harassment was heard. After the judge learned that the complainant was a political opponent, he properly recused himself from her cases.

The second judge had no duty to notify the complainant when her neighbors appeared in court to swear out a petition against harassment. This procedure is expressly permitted by law.

Because the contents of the complaint do not support the claims, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

COMPLAINT ABOUT [REDACTED] JUDGES

August 21, 2007

CJC-07-225

The case involves a Injunction Against Harassment. In [REDACTED] I was called into court because I asked a neighbor to stay of my property and to keep their destructive cats and children at home. Up until that time I had never spoken to them except to ask them to remove their trash from my property. The first day they started to move in to their home, they threw their empty boxes, along with several other items on my property.

The summons said to bring any evidence and witnesses you might have, so, I arrived at court with evidence that would show the court that the [REDACTED] where not telling the truth. Judge [REDACTED] was presiding. Even though I told him, I had photos, he did not let me display this to the court, (I've read "Rules of Evidence", so I know it was good evidence.) He went on to find me guilty and issued the Injunction of harassment against me. I still feel he was trying to get even with me for running a don't vote for [REDACTED] campaign against him, when he ran for office.

The [REDACTED] came in and asked for Injunction Against Harassment Modification in [REDACTED] I was called in again. Judge [REDACTED] was presiding. He refused the modification.

Several weeks later, I get a letter in the mail stating another hearing was set for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] I received the letter on [REDACTED] Several days later I was served with another Injunction of Harassment from the [REDACTED] even though I notified the Judge first thing Monday morning that I was not served in time to attend the hearing.

I called and complained and was told, "to bad." I feel my constitutional rights have been denied me. Don't I have the right to face my accusers? I would like to at least be at my hearing.

I am part of a long time generational Arizona family. I have heard things like this happening in other small towns in Arizona, but have never witnessed anything like this. I have lived here for about 3 years now, and it has been a nightmare. A normal thinking person would be alarmed at some of the things I have witnessed happening in this Justice Court. The Judge is an [REDACTED] ex-deputy and between him and other law enforcement officers, I suspect they railroad anyone that asks their rights as a US citizen not be severed.

I have just now discovered that these guys are trying to harass me into not complaining about their tactics here. The Judge and several of the [REDACTED] officers are trying to scare me into not writing letters to Arizona Government and asking that they inspect the spooky way in which this town is allowed to approach law abiding citizens.

I will be adding another complaint about other things that have happened here at a later time, because they are attacking at all sides right now. I have enclosed a complaint I filed with the [REDACTED] Police Department Chief that will help you understand what is going on.
