Dear Sir:

Although I am filing a
Complaint against Judge [REDACTED]
Regarding my Case No. [REDACTED]
in the [REDACTED] Justice court, I felt
compelled to write you regarding this matter.
To begin with in 1999 I lost my companion
of 23 years, during the last four years
of his life I stayed with him 24 hours
a day 7 days a week 365 days a year, even
with my own health concerns, the small
amount of money he received from the VA
we were able to survive. Within days
of ~~him~~ his death I was hospitalized for
chest pains and depression at the [REDACTED]
hospital in [REDACTED] AZ. Upon being
admitted I was placed on AHCCCS thru
the office in [REDACTED] AZ. After
my release from the hospital I started
paperwork to apply for social security
disability. Over the next several months
I keep receiving medical bills from the
doctors and the hospital. When I discussed
the problem with my case worker she
sent me the adult protective services
people out to see me and had them

2) bring copies of my coverage thru AHCCCS with a letter telling me that when ever I received bills for medical treatment to place a copy of the form in there envelope and return it to them. Except for the hospital that seemed to take care of the problem.

I made several trips to the billing office and gave them a copy of the + letter in person to get the matter taken care of. The hospital instead of correcting the problem, turned me over to a collection agency. The man I talked to on my last visit [redacted] said he would take care of it. Over the next several years the collection agency called and harassed me on a weekly basis. Not being able to deal with these people I contacted an attorney.

During the process of resolving this matter the collection agency got an order from Judge [redacted] to garnish my wages from my employer even tho I had filed the paperwork with the court showing I had AHCCCS coverage at the time. It took several months but the judge over turned that disicision and my employer had to return my money.

My attorney filed paperwork for a trail date but the collection agency kept getting it postponed stating they were

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waiting on paper work From AHCCCS. My Attorney informed The collection agency that what they did was illegal and offered to settle the matter out of court, but they refused.

When my case did go before Judge [redacted] he didn't seem to care that the hospital and collection agency broke the law, and had put me thru hell for several years, they dropped the original complaint and just added two new bills that should have been paid for by my employer as they were workmans comp claims that the hospital should have filed against instead of [redacted] my insurance carrier at the time. At the trial I told Judge Overson the only other times I was seen at the hospital was for work related injuries. None of the facts in my case seem to be of concern to Judge [redacted]. During a short recess Judge [redacted] approached both attorneys and asked them to enlighten him about my case as he was unsure of what it was about. Given all the facts in this matter and the illegal judgement against me my attorney felt confident that the judge would rule in my favor. Well Surprise Surprise

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He Ruled in Favor of The collection Agency. Where is The justice in This case ?

My Attorney said we could Appeal but it would cost more money AND time. And it may even go back to The same judge who would never overturn his own decision.

I had already paid over \$2,000.00 dollars AS it was AND couldn't AFFORD to pay For AN Appeal.

My Attorney said Since my home was homesteaded AND I had no income Since I was Recovering From a Stroke AND Fighting For disability The collection agency couldn't get The money ANYway So just For get About it. I had my Attorney contact The collection agency AND offer to pay the 20% OF The bills That my insurance carrier didn't pay even Tho it should have been paid by workmans comp. But They Refused. Saying they had The judgment From The court AND That is All They would except. Well They will be waiting For a long time because I don't intend to pay Them one dime For All The hell They put me Thru.
