The trial started in The jury began its deliberations on On the afternoon of received a call from her place of summer employment told her that two other would be out the next day and that it was imperative that be at work the next day.

informed the bailiff that she needed to be at work the next day and could not continue to participate in deliberations. The bailiff acknowledges giving permission to leave.

The next day, did not appear for jury duty, Judge issued an order to show cause and set a show cause hearing for The judge did this despite the bailiff's partial explanation. At the hearing Judge made intemperate

remarks to and stated facts he knew at the time to be incorrect. The bailiff made no attempt on to correct those factual errors.

As a result of Judge actions my daughter was subjected to an investigation and prosecution for contempt of court. Fortunately after interviews with the bailiff and Judge it became apparent did nothing wrong. It also became apparent that Judge knew the facts of the case yet proceeded with an order to show cause investigation. His conduct toward was strikingly similar to some of the complaints raised recently about Judge.

This investigation/prosecution has now been dropped by the Special Prosecutor, and the judge assigned to hear the OSC, Honorable My daughter had counsel throughout this investigation. Counsel's name is at the law firm of The representation of my daughter cost us thousands of dollars and created undue anguish and emotional distress in my family.

I wish the Commission on Judicial Conduct to investigate. My daughter, my wife and I as well as our counsel are willing to cooperate. Enclosed are appropriate and relevant transcripts and orders for your review.
