her know that was false information. My husband was charged with a class 6 for marijuana and a class 2 for narcotic drugs, but they dismissed the class 6 and dropped the class 2 to a class 4 for possession. On my husband plea they had him down for two class 4 when it was one.

On my husband went to jail that day in courtroom when he signed a plea and when he got booked it was for one account of class 4 for possession, but that day the Judge asked you charging him with two of the same account? and he said "yes" she asked why? said, "we split them physically into two bags" that's illegal and she knew it that's tampering with evidence aint suppose to separate drugs him and the prosecutor. My husband only agreed to sign a plea for possession one class 4, but when we went to court hurried up and changed the plea and lied to us about what was said on there and had my husband signed it. Every since told something in court she just don't want to see the mistakes that has been took in her court building and I feel as a Judge you suppose to make sure they get a fair trial, I told her he didn't have a settlement conference or anything.
