COMPLAINT AGAINST JUDGES

This case originated by Justice Court Judge placing a complaint against myself.

The case was transferred to the City Court, ostensibly to find a "neutral place" for this complaint, where the "victim" is a Judge in the Justice Court. The case was assigned to Judge and tried sometime in

What Judges DID NOT DISCLOSE, is that they ^{knew} each other for many years.
This is not surprising
Only during , the two Judges did attend together at least two judicial conferences.
In one of those conferences they sat at the same table !

There was obviously an enormous conflict of interest in trying this case. Not only was he biased naturally as the "victim" was another Judge ; but this was a Judge that he had a past relationship with. Yet he did not disqualify himself as the minimum honesty and decency would have required him to do so. Neither Judge has the honesty and decency to do the same.

Quite to the contrary, both of them saw this as the ideal and may be the only setting to make something "criminal" out of events that they have no merit whatsoever !

The complaint was obviously a retaliatory revenge by Judge , (who earlier convicted me), against whom a did file a Judiciary Complaint, two years ago, with this Commission. This was a separate complaint then the one presented in Appendix One and it was filed around two years ago with this Commission.
