When approaching the bench judge. Says - "Now why are we here," I tried to briefly explain and presented my paperwork he cut me short and said "Now why are we here," and he could see I WAS getting upset. When I told him that since the attorneys office staff was cleared out and new people were there I could not contact the one woman that I made the settlement with, but we did - she was dismissed so I did not get my letter. judge

Response was: "I bet you hope you don't see her on the street, and since you did a phone transaction you cannot prove it was paid." So maybe next time you will send a check!

If he would have taken the time to review my case - the common sense would have been explained, but he did not.

He was rude, and made no effort to understand my reasoning for trying to appeal this over + over. It was as if this was a joke to him. Please read my pleas and requests to the judge.

Basically I requested that he read my statements and understand this was not a neglected problem on my part, I did what WAS ASKED - I made the mistake of doing a phone transaction, but I did it ASSUMING the other party WAS honest, which they weren't.

This attorney has made many mistakes. I just received someone else's paperwork. they will not work with me to (Attach additional sheets as needed) settle - they were calling me 24 hours to collect - office did not know about learn sheets.
