I WISH TO BRING TO YOUR ATTENTION THE RECENT BEHAVIOR BY JUDGE DURING MY JURY TRIAL. THIS COMPLAINT IS NOT MEANT TO ADDRESS HIS COURT RULINGS, SIMPLY HIS DEMEANOR WHILE ON THE BENCH DURING TRIAL.

JUDGES WHO ARE APPOINTED TO PRESIDE OVER JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS SHOULD BE UNBIASED AND UNPRESUDICIAL. JUDGE WAS NOT. DURING TRIAL I REPRESENTED MYSELF DURING A VERY COMPLEX CASE LASTING NEARLY EIGHT (8) WEEKS. IN FRONT OF THE JURY JUDGE WOULD FREQUENTLY COMPLAIN HOW LONG TRIAL WAS LASTING AND UTILIZE BODY LANGUAGE MAKING MYSELF FEEL HUMILIATED IN FRONT OF THE JURY.

I REALIZE FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE ACCUSED, JUDICIAL BIAS IS OFTEN ALLEGED IN COMPLAINTS. YOU WILL NOTICE I HAVE ATTACHED A COPY OF A LETTER FROM THE ATTORNEY WHO WAS MY ADVISORY COUNSEL. AT TRIAL JUDGE INFORMED MY ATTORNEY I WAS NOT TO ENTER HIS CHAMBERS FOR FEAR I WOULD SEE JUDGE FAMILY PICTURES. JUDGE OBVIOUSLY FELT I WAS GUILTY BEFORE TRIAL.

FOLLOWING TRIAL I ALSO FILED A MOTION, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED REQUESTING THE COURTROOM VIDEO FEEDS TO BE PRESERVED. THE VIDEOS, IF REVIEWED, WOULD HAVE SHOWN THIS BEHAVIOR. BECAUSE I CAN'T GET THOSE VIDEOS, PLEASE CONSULT WITH THE WITNESSES LISTED ABOVE. I AM SURE THEY WILL CONFIRM MY COMPLAINT
