1) The Complainant,

; a Petition for Post-Conviction Relief
(Rule 32) on ; received an Order

a Motion To Set and Readiness on
2008; and finally, a Notice To The Honorable
of Sixty (60) Day State
Constitution Violation, to Rule on Pending Rule

3) To date, Judge (the trial
