I read an article in our newspaper on Oct. 2, 2008 about a child never getting the support money that was being sent. I have had that same problem for years.

I am an 80 year old man that has had \$300 a month taken our of my Social Security every month since 1997. It is supposed to go to a child that was born in 1978 and is married and has a fine family of her own. Some of it seems to disappear after it gets to the clearinghouse. I have a print out from the clearinghouse that shows there were some refunds taken out of it. The printout doesn't say who gets the refunds but I know it isn't me.

The District Attorney's Office started this scam in 1992 but it took them until 1997 before they found a judge to sign a court order to take the money out of my Social Security fund.

There was a court review of my case by Judge 11-3-06. He stated that this should terminate in 21 months from that date. We have already past up the 24th month since then. They must not have calendars into the court house. Some day there will be an audit of that bank for the Judicial System and see where the clearinghouse money really went. I would not be surprised if the address for clearinghouse was the same as that of the District Attorney that instigated this scam in 1992.

I have sent certified and registered letters to the Clerk of the Superior Court and Judge and Economic Security and others about this scam but no reply so far.

It doesn't seem right that someone in the Judicial System need some of my Social Security Retirement Fund more than I do. I am an 80 year old senior citizen trying to live off that fund.
